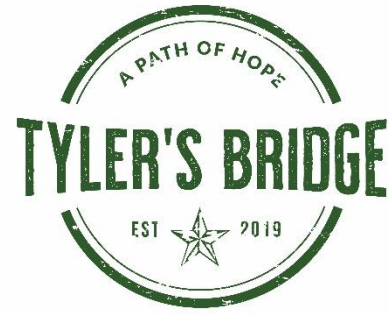


# 2024-2025 Tyler's Bridge Scholarship Fund



The Tyler's Bridge Scholarship Fund exists to offer scholarships and financial assistance to High School, Trade School and College students who are financially in need and/or, in order to assist them in the pursuit of educational advancement.

**Available Scholarships:** Four (4) scholarships for \$2,000 each (Totaling \$8,000) are available to the following:

1. Current High School Seniors in the Katy Independent School District
2. Active in the FFA and Agriculture Science Program
3. Will be attending a 2–4-year college, University or Trade School in Texas
4. Must have a GPA of 2.5
5. Satisfactorily demonstrated the characteristics of citizenship, leadership, academic achievement, and involved in school and community service and activities

## **Program Guidelines & Priorities:**

Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the College, Trade School or University in August 2024 and not to the student. It will be the student's responsibility to submit to Tyler's Bridge at that time the student ID number and college information. NO scholarship funds will be released without a tuition invoice or proof of enrollment. Funds will be disbursed directly to the school upon receipt of tuition invoice and/or proof of enrollment.

\* Scholar recipients are asked to attend the 2024 Annual Taps and Turbos Fundraising Event and the 2025 Katy ISD FFA Livestock Show and Rodeo Parade.

## **Applications must include the following:**

1. A completed application
2. A letter of reference, by a non-family member, attesting to your character for this scholarship (mailed by the referee)
3. A copy of your transcript (this can be unofficial)
4. A resume

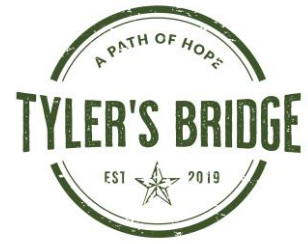
